


WORM IN THE APPLE

Lesson of the Day:

We have to share our things with others who need them. Sometimes we find an apple that has a worm inside and we get upset or annoyed. But that worm needs to eat too!

Make sure you are sharing things with people in need when possible. If your friend needs a pencil and you have two, share! Sharing is a great way to show people you care.



Materials:

- Green construction paper
- Paper plate
- Googly eyes

- Markers/crayons
- Brown construction paper
- Glue

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students make a small green paper chain with thin, pre-cut green rectangles of paper. They can also cut these themselves.
- 3. Add a face with googly eyes to the front of the paper chain.
- 4. Have students color a paper plate the color of the apple they like-red, yellow, or green.
- 5. Have students cut the edges of the paper plate to the shape of an apple. Add leaves and a stem.
